323 BC - The Hellenistic period begins when Alexander the Great dies. The Ancient Greek civilization begins its decline and the Ancient Romans start to gain power. **508 BC - Democracy is introduced in Athens** by Cleisthenes. **650 BC** - The Greek Tyrants come into power. Cypselus is the first Tyrant of Corinth (a city-state in Greece). 2. **490 BC -** The Greeks fight the Persians in the Greek/Persian Wars. The Greeks win and the Persians retreat. 3. **336 BC** - The great philosopher, scientist, and mathematician, Aristotle, begins to tutor Alexander the Great. He becomes king when his father, Philip of Macedon is 4. assassinated. 5. **431 BC -** The wars between Sparta and Athens begin. They are called the **Peloponnesian Wars.** The wars will last 27 years with Sparta eventually conquering Athens in 404 BC. 6. 776 BC - The first Olympic Games takes place. The games would take place every 4 years in honor of the Greek god Zeus.
